We are currently seeking a Business Resiliency Specialist to administer this program. The successful candidate will facilitate a customized support plan, then work with the business's principals throughout their journey to recovery.

Responsibilities of the Business Resiliency Specialist include but are not limited to:

- Initiating daily phone calls to regional tourism businesses to recruit them into the program, as well as gather other information to help them succeed during any pandemic or emergency situation.
- Developing 'Support Response' documents.
- Contributing ideas and feedback for the continued betterment of the program delivery.
- Working with the Marketing and Destination Development departments to manage all external communications and ensure alignment with other activities.

- Conducting survey work through one on one calls to businesses to provide valuable research.
- Demonstrating an empathetic response to stakeholders, and using active listening techniques to help the stakeholder to determine what support and service they require as they navigate the COVID-19 crisis.
- Other duties as required.

Requirements of the Business Resiliency Specialist:

- Strong computer skills including Customer Relationship Management (CRM).
- Strong communication, writing and customer management skills that may include deescalating difficult situations.
- An attention to detail and good note-taking skills.
- Ability to create reports and provide metrics on the success of the program. •
- A strong background in marketing, communications, stakeholder relationships or client care is preferred.
